

faith, point others to the gospel, and remember God's providence will never take you to a place where His grace will not sustain you.




## (Women's Class) Anxious For Nothing (Author: Max Lucado)







## "Why We Trust the Bible" - 6 weeks and "Knowing Scripture"- 12 weeks.


<u>Why We Trust the Bible</u> God Has Spoken God's revelation: where would we be without it? In this series, Dr. Stephen Nichols explains that we would be lost if not for God's Word, trapped in the darkness of sin forever. Rather than forsake us, God sent His Son, Jesus, revealing and recording His redemptive purposes in an inspired, inerrant, and authoritative source: the Bible. Sufficient for all of life, a crucial question arises: will we accept its authority?

<u>Knowing Scripture</u> shows us that it is the privilege and duty of every believer to diligently study God's Word. It reminds us that along with this privilege comes the responsibility to interpret the Bible correctly. Dr. R.C. Sproul teaches that interpreting Scripture, like all sciences, is governed by rules. He lays out the basic guidelines for correctly understanding, interpreting, and applying Scripture, using time-tested principles from Scripture to show how to find the true meaning of its contents. This series is a great study tool for both beginning and long-time Bible readers.



**Relengage** Would you rate your marriage as a 2 or a 10? Maybe even a 0? You are not alone. Whether your marriage needs to be reignited, or is in need of a complete resurrection, relengage is a safe place for couples to reconnect. Relengage is a marriage enrichment program that examines God's design for marriage and applies principles from the Bible to guide couples towards growth in their relationship with each other.

The Re|engage classes are always taking new people. There is no start date, it goes on continually. Couples can come any week.

#### Welcome!

First, let me tell you how happy we are that you have taken this first step to "intentionally engaging" solutions (i.e. Solutions). This portion of the catalog introduces you to Support Groups. Support Groups address experiences that are common to the participants. They are often experiences that a person has a difficult time overcoming individually.

Participating in a support group has many benefits. Participants indicate the biggest advantage is the realization they are not alone. While listening to others share their experiences they realize that there are other people who have the same problems. This revelation provides relief. New skills to relate to others are developed while providing the community needed for healing.

What can you expect? Support groups vary but basically you can expect a small group (8-10 people) meeting weekly to discuss their experience. Homework to be done individually may be given. Unlike group therapy, the meeting is led by a lay person with training in facilitating the group discussion.

When joining a support group, you may be uncomfortable at first when it comes time to discussing problems in front of strangers. However, the fact that others are facing the same type of situation will help you open up and discuss your feelings. Additionally, the guidelines shared in group weekly remind participants that everything that takes place within the support group should be kept confidential.






#### **CANCER WARRIORS**
