- **6:00am to 9:00am:** Check-in. Please be ready to start cooking by 9:00am
- **12:00pm to 1:00pm:** Hot dog lunch with devotional time.
- **1:00pm to 4:30pm:** More cooking and fellowship (Horseshoes and Washers)

NOTE—Turn-in time for meats:

Ribs—2:00pm

Chicken—2:45pm

Chef's Choice—3:30pm

- **4:30pm:** Families are welcome. River, Horseshoes, Washers, Corn Hole and Volleyball will be available.
- **5:00pm:** Award ceremony

OAKWOOD MENS BBQ COOK-OFF RULES

1. A \$60.00 entry fee per each team is required. You will receive 2 chicken and 2 racks of ribs at 8 am and you will pay your \$60.00 team registration fee at that time. (Chief cook only) You will bring your own raw meat of choice for the Chef's Choice.
2. The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of the team. No more than five cooks per team are allowed. Each team will be responsible for the clean up of their space.
3. Prizes will be awarded 1st and 2nd in chicken, 1st and 2nd in ribs and 1st and 2nd for chef's choice.
4. Judging will follow the OBC rules and regulations. The chief cook will have barbeque at the judging area on time. One container of each category will be judged. All entries must be in containers supplied by officials. Barbeque will be judged on aroma, appearance, texture and taste.
5. Fires must be of wood or wood substance, charcoal is acceptable. No electric or gas grills. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. Each team will be responsible for their team members and guests.
6. Competition meats cannot be seasoned, marinated or on the pit before the official start time. The official start time is 9 am Saturday morning. No pre-cooked, pre-boiled or pre-marinated meats. Cooking (including seasoning or marinating) will not begin until 9 am.
7. Contestants may begin setting up anytime between 6 am and 9 am, Saturday.
8. Contestants must provide their own tables, chairs and tents if so desired. There will be no electricity provided but water will be available.
9. Turn-in time for ribs is 2:00 pm, 2:45 pm for chicken and 3:30 for chef's choice. All awards will be given out at 5:00 pm.



PORK RIBS

1. Contestants will receive (2) racks of ribs after check-in (8:00-9:00 am).
2. You must cook one whole slab of ribs for judging, plus one for donation for the meal and dance that evening.
3. Ribs may be put on the fire at 9:00 am.
4. Judging of meat is based upon appearance, color, aroma, tenderness and taste. (1-10, 10 being the best).

CHICKEN

1. Contestants will receive (2) whole chickens after check-in (8:00-9:00 am).
2. You must cook one whole chicken for judging, plus one for donation for the meal and dance that evening.
3. Chicken may be put on the fire at 9:00 am.
4. Judging of meat is based upon appearance, color, aroma, tenderness and taste. (1-10, 10 being the best).

CHEF'S CHOICE

1. Contestants will purchase their own (raw) chicken, pork, beef, seafood or combinations and any garnishes. Limit portions to 4-8 ounces.
2. Meat may be put on fire anytime after 9:00 am
3. Judging of meat is based on presentation, color, aroma and taste. Use your imagination (1-10, 10 being the best)
